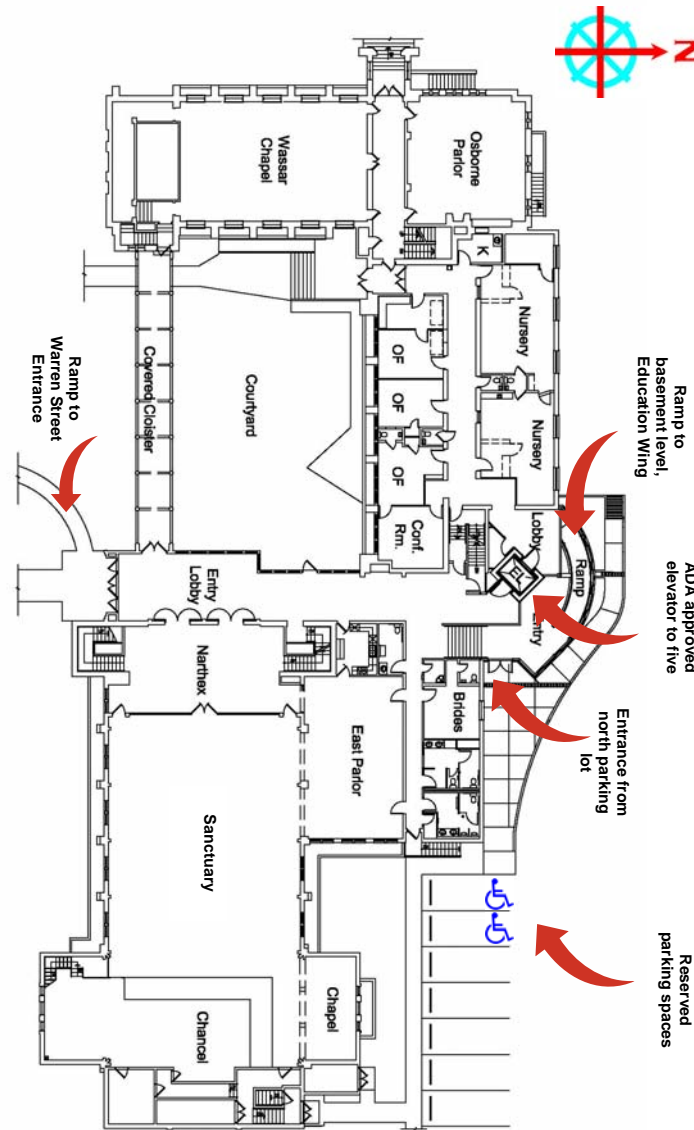

Types of accommodations for special needs persons:

- Special Needs Kiosk with information and supplies in Narthex
- Reserved parking spaces
- Pew cuts for wheelchair and walker access in both the Sanctuary and Wasser Chapel
- Two family-assist bathrooms and two bathrooms with handicap stalls
- Elevator access to all but one location in the building
- Indoor and outdoor ramps
- Assistive listening devices for the main sanctuary
- Large-print hymnals
- Large-print *Upper Room* Devotional booklets
- Durable medical supply closet including wheelchairs, walkers, shower stools, etc., for loaning.
